POST OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR PENOSCROTAL SURGERY

IMPORTANT PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1. If you have a dressing or bandage on your wound, remove it on the first day after your surgery, unless instructed by your doctor.
2. Showers are allowed, but no bathing, hot-tubing, or swimming. Children should have a sponge bath only.
3. Apply Neosporin (triple antibiotic) ointment to your wound two to three times daily for the next few days only. This may be purchased over the counter in any pharmacy. If circumcision was performed, gently pull the shaft of the penis so it does not adhere to the area of circumcision.
4. No sexual activity or physical exertion until the doctor has cleared you to do so.
5. Call the doctor immediately for any fever, marked swelling, or pain.
6. Take your prescribed medicine as directed. Your pain pills (Lortab, Percocet, or Darvocet N-100) should only be taken as needed for pain.
7. Someone from our staff will contact you the next business day after your surgery to check on your condition and to schedule your follow-up appointment. If you have not been contacted within this time frame, please contact our office as soon as possible.

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
