## **UROFLOW AND BLADDER ULTRASOUND**

### **IMPORTANT PLEASE READ COMPLETELY**

#### **WHAT IS IT?**

The flow study will show the force with which you urinate. The ultrasound will measure the amount of urine left in your bladder after urination.

#### **WHAT WILL HAPPEN?**

When you arrive for your appointment you will be asked to urinate into a container in privacy. You will then go into another room for the ultrasound.

#### **HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE?**

The entire procedure takes approximately 15-20 minutes.

#### **HOW DO I PREPARE FOR THIS TEST?**

You will need to drink 16oz to 18 oz of water two hours prior to your appointment time. It is extremely important that you arrive to your appointment with a full bladder and a strong desire to urinate. It takes your kidney a couple of hours to process what you drink. If your bladder is not full, you will be asked to reschedule your appointment.

**DO NOT URINATE UNTIL THE NURSE BRINGS YOU BACK TO BEGIN THE TEST!**
